- 1) Shri DATTATREYA RAMACHANDRA KAPREKAR (17 January 1905 to 4 July 1986), a member of the HARDY-RAMANUJAN SOCIETY passed away in Nasik city. He was awarded a prize from the Society for his work on numbers.
- 2) It was a long standing conjecture of Th. SCHNEIDER that at least one of the numbers e^e and $\text{Exp}(e^2)$ is transcendental. This was proved independently around the same time by D. BROWNAWELL and M. WALDSCHMIDT. For this work they have been awarded the distinguished award of the HARDY-RAMANUJAN SOCIETY. The award is £ 20 each and is meant for the purchase of one volume of the collected works of S. RAMANUJAN, G.H. HARDY, J.E. LITTLEWOOD, I.M. VINOGRADOV, H. DAVENPORT, P. TURAN and Yu. V. LINNIK. The magnitude of the award is not important. The award is an indication of the respect of the Society to the work of these authors.
