1. Professor TIKAO TATUZAWA (03-02-1915 to 21-12-1997)

He was one of the finest Analytic Number Theorists of JAPAN and is responsible for encouraging Analytic Number Theorists of JAPAN. A well-known student of his is Professor YOICHI MOTOHASHI whose students Professors HIROSHI MIKAWA and KOICHI KAWADA are also well-known. His influence on Japanese Analytic Theory of Numbers is well-known. I list a few workers in this area who were either directly or indirectly influenced by his life's motto (namely to spread the subject): Professors KOHJI MATSUMOTO, MASANORI KATSURADA, ISAO KIUCHI, IEKATA SHIOKAWA, KUMIKO NISHIOKA, MASAYOSHI HATA, NORIKO HIRATA KOHNO, MASAKI AMOU, TAKAAKI TANAKA and MAKOTO NAGATA. Special mention has to be made of late Professor TAKAYOSHI MITUSUI whose details are given separately. Professors K. RAMACHANDRA and TAUZAWA met at MOSCOW (STEKLOV INSTITUTE) in September 1981 at the 90th birthday celebration of Professor I. M. VINOGRADOV. Needless to say that both were very great admirers of VINOGRADOV.

2. Professor TAKAYOSHI MITUSUI (20-01-1929 to 01-10-1997).

Another loss to Japan in Analytic Number theory was Professor T. MITSUI. He was a great admirer of I. M. VINOGRADOV whose work was generalised by him.
